

Study tour through three countries

Come with us to a study tour through the Netherlands, Germany and Poland. All of these countries have their specialities in agriculture, which you experience in that tour.

1st Day: Amsterdam

Arrival at Amsterdam Airport. Transfer into the city centre. Guided tour with boat ride on the town canals and dinner on board. Overnight in the Amsterdam area.

2nd Day: Technical visits around Amsterdam

In the morning visit to a dairy farm with a mobile milking robot. Later on, visit to the embassy. Overnight as the day before.



3th Day: Technical visits - Germany

First, you will visit the polder-land, which is recovered from the sea and an experimental farm, which belongs to the Agricultural University. Discussion with authorities about the influence of climate changes to this very special area in the Netherlands. Transfer to Germany and staying overnight in the Lower Rhine area.

4th Day: Technical visits in Lower Rhine area

Whole-day programme at a study farm. You could put an emphasis on organic farming, hogs, dairy, general farming or the agricultural educational system in Germany.

5th Day: Region in transformation

You will visit farms in the near surroundings, e.g. farms, which had to be moved due to coal mining

activities. Possible is also a visit to the former industrial area "Ruhrgebiet", which is in a rapid and constant change.



6th Day: Former inner-German border

Transfer to the former inner-German border. Guided tour through the border-museum, where you also find old border facilities. According to your special interests, special issues could be discussed more detailed. Overnight near Göttingen.

7th Day: Capital Berlin

In the early afternoon you will reach the German capital. Within the sightseeing tour, you will see highlights like the famous Brandenburger Tor. Check-in at the hotel in Berlin.

8th Day: Transfer to Poland

After breakfast visit to the embassy. Then you head on to Poland and visit an experimental farm of the University of Agriculture. Transfer to Poznan, where you will stay overnight. In the evening round table talk about the development of the rural area with local experts.

9th Day: Technical visits - Wroclaw

On the way to Wroclaw you will pay a visit to a small family farm. After the lunch in the nice students' city Wroclaw, you will meet with authorities and discuss the influence of the accession to the EU on the agriculture in Poland. Overnight in Wroclaw.

10th Day: Technical visits around Wroclaw

In the morning transfer to the Opole area and visit to a successful family farm. At the lunch, you will also meet with a member of the local farmers' union. In the afternoon you will visit a family that not only deals with its own farm, but also has a small bakery. Transfer back to the hotel in Wroclaw.

11th Day: Transfer to Germany

You will leave Poland and drive towards Rothenburg o.T., where you will stay overnight. On the way, visit to a farmers' cooperative in the Bautzen area.

12th Day: Hohenlohe

That day you will get information about the project "Agricultural Tourism" in the region Hohenlohe and will discuss with partners on how networking has affected their business. It is also possible to visit a farmers' cooperative producing hogs based on an old traditional local breed. Overnight as the day before.



13th Day: Energy - Rothenburg

In the morning visit to a Energy Centre, where you will get information about solar energy projects and biogas plants. After the lunch-break, guided tour through the picturesque medieval town Rothenburg.

14th Day: Return trip

Transfer to the Airport Frankfurt/Main and flight back home.
